

Nature Based Solutions Executive Order

- Promote pollinators, healthy soils
- Natural and Working Lands Climate Smart Strategy
- Scoping plans: nature-based solutions; farmer and rancher-led solutions
- Accelerated restoration
- Commitment to conserve 30% of lands and coastal waters by 2030 (30x30)

30x30 Conservation Areas


"Land and coastal water areas that are durably protected and managed to support functional ecosystems, both intact and restored, and the species that rely on them."





CONSERVATION OF LANDS


- Broad Range of Landscape



- Initial Investments
 - Nature-Based Solutions Set Aside -- \$758 Million
 - Coastal Resilience -- \$500 Million
 - Habitat Restoration -- \$645 Million
 - Wildlife Corridors -- \$105 Million
