

The Beverly Hills/Benedict Canyon Area is a north-south canyon that lies between Mulholland Drive (North) and Sunset Blvd (South), San Ysidro Drive to the (East) and Beverly Glen to the (West). This area contains medium to heavy brush. It is a densely populated area that maintains narrow streets, roadways and long private driveways. Many of the homes are located in the canyon and on ridges. Evacuating homeowners can create the potential for difficult access for all responding emergency apparatus. Utilizing Sunset Blvd. can manage access into this location.


