Subject: rules for slash

Warning: this message is from an external user and should be treated with caution.

We need tighter rules for timber slash treatment associated with timber harvest plans. Lop & scatter as typically implemented leaves too much fuel on the ground.

Regulations could recommend removal, chipping, pile burning or have the forester propose a treatment.

If lop and scatter is appropriate in certain areas, contact with ground should be required with spacing of materials away from trunks of leave trees, slash no higher than 12" (unless a large log), should be able to see the ground between slash - or something similar.
